Ensuring **safety and security** through advanced operational planning and incident response, GXP OpsView<sup>™</sup> now includes access to GXP Xplorer<sup>®</sup> and GXP WebView<sup>®</sup>!

The following provides detail on several of the **key product enhancements** delivered in the GXP OpsView v2.I release.

### 1. Integration with additional GXP capabilities

- a. GXP Xplorer provides additional data discovery and management capabilities, allowing for easy access to enterprise content, as well as advanced sharing and integration
- b. GXP WebView adds a streaming image viewer with drawing and measurement capabilities, allowing users to publish visual reports of their findings
- Incident data appears in GXP Xplorer, providing summary information about the Incident and also allowing the user to 'Open that Incident' directly through GXP OpsView

### 2. Group-based access

- a. Only people in your Group see your location
- b. User administrators see and manage their own Groups

## 3. Incident updates

- a. Incident names appear on each Incident on the map
- b. Clickable Incident footprints allow for easy drill-down into an Incident
- c. Incident File overviews show the full image and include a Close button

#### 4. Newer and more usable Roles

- a. Increased control over system access
- b. Secure 'least-privilege' concept in action
- 5. Set a default landing page to get to your preferred page faster
- 6. Enhanced icons (smaller and sharper for better visibility)
